Inception and Development

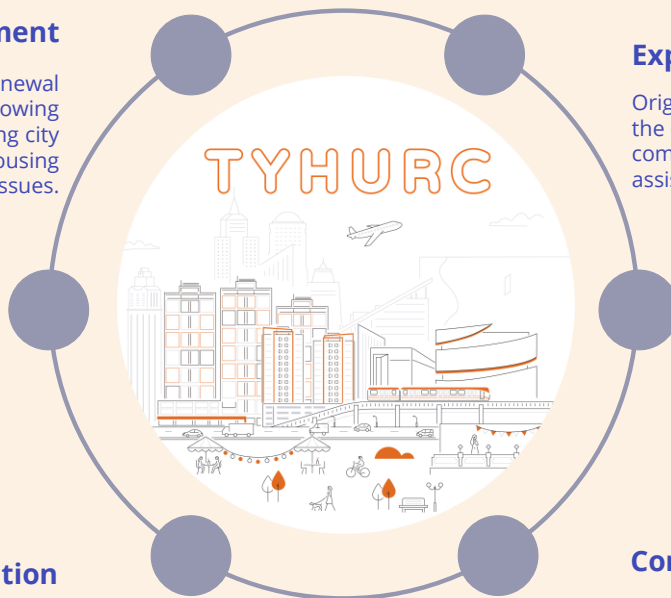
The Taoyuan City Housing and Urban Renewal Center was officially established in 2024, following extensive research and discussions among city planners and stakeholders regarding housing issues.
